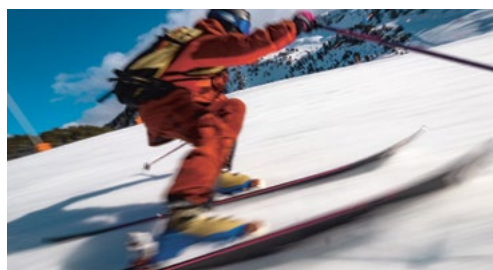

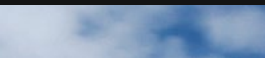

THE MOST FAMOUS INTERNATIONAL EVENTS
WILL BE THE FIFTH EDITION OF THE
FREERIDE WORLD TOUR BAQUEIRA PRO
BY MOVISTAR, THE BEST KNOWN INTERNATIONAL
FREERIDE CIRCUIT, TAKING PLACE
FROM 15 TO 21 JANUARY,
AND THE MEN'S FIS ALPINE SKI EUROPA CUP,
SCHEDULED FOR 3 AND 4 FEBRUARY.

The world's best ski and snowboard freeride event is scheduled to take over the northwest side of Baciver, hosting the world's best riders once again. Meanwhile, the continental alpine competition will be held at Beret's Fernández Ochoa Stadium, welcoming the best skiers in the speciality, many of them World Cup participants.

This season's agenda will see the return of classic charity or social enterprise events (awarding student scholarships) such as the 18th edition of the **Open Ski Jesús Serra Fundación Occident Trophy** on 7 March. The Foundation is also holding phase 1 of the **Inclusive Spanish Cup** 24 and 25 on January. The **TOP CAEI FIS alpine skiing** is scheduled for 14 and 15 March, while the **Spanish-Movistar snowboardcross and skicross championships** will be held between January 31 and February 1.

Popular events for individuals or small groups include the standout **Baqueira Race Em Aran**. In the final stretch of the season, this fun event invites participants to explore the entire area on the 21th of March.

And the calendar wouldn't be complete without the more traditional alpine ski races. The **IV Blanca Fernández Ochoa Memorial Trophy** race kicks off Baqueira's alpine competition fixtures on the 20th and 21st of December at the Beret Stadium. The **Marxa Beret** is another must. This benchmark in cross-country skiing is now in its 46th edition and will be held on Sunday 1st of February, with participants including the best European cross-country skiers as well as families and enthusiasts. The **Masters World Cup** will take to Beret Stadium for skiers from the age of 30, held from the 20th to the 22nd of February with super-G, giant and slalom races.

Baqueira Beret is home to a wide and varied range of sports and leisure venues. The Beret Fernández Ochoa Stadium is a highlight, where local clubs have trained Olympic champions like Paul de la Cuesta, Andrea Jardí and Alex Puente – all CAEI members – and Juan de Campo – CEVA. Added to this are the toboggan run, snowshoe circuit, 7 kilometres signposted for cross-country skiing, as well as the snowpark, funpark, and boardercross to complete the experience.

These are the BaqueiraPASS and BaqueiraTICKET, both of which can be easily topped up online, with a physical card valid for several seasons. For adults, the 25/26 season day rate is €67.50. This **named** pass is for the exclusive use of the holder only, providing improved security and personalisation. The BaqueiraPASS offers reduced rates compared to the BaqueiraTICKET, with the added convenience of being able to manage everything online.

Holders can top up their own, as well as family and friends' passes, via the website. Once you've topped up your pass, all that's left is to head to the resort and take to the slopes. You can apply for a BaqueiraPASS and the resort will send it to your home address, with a processing fee of €25, and it can be reused season after season.

Another major advantage is that skiers can manage all the usual operations once the card has been issued, when logged in: top up your ski pass, check invoices and track your accumulated ski days. What's more, the **official Baqueira Beret App** gives you access to exclusive services such as restaurant reservations or the new Ski Track features, and you can share your location with other users.

Lastly, you can head to the resort's website to plan your day's skiing, with up-to-date weather forecasts and live webcams and livecams so you can check the status of the slopes in the different areas of Baqueira, Beret, and Bonaigua.

The adult day price for the 25/26 season is €71.50. This **unnamed** card is free of charge and reusable for several seasons, making it the most practical and flexible option for you to enjoy Baqueira Beret – without having to plan ahead.

You can collect a card in person from various information points in the resort, equipment purchase, rental, and repair shops, from hotels in the Aran Valley and Valls d'Àneu, tourist offices, and other participating establishments. Once you have the card, you can easily top it up online through the Baqueira Beret website or app. You can also buy ski passes without previously having a BaqueiraTICKET: in this case, after paying, the skier will receive a link with the purchase information, which can then be linked with the physical card when it's collected from any of the collaborating points.

Please note that to access the ski lifts, you must physically carry your topped up BaqueiraTICKET. Purchasing a ski pass without the card will not give you direct access. Top-ups will be available online from the day before the resort opens, making it easier for skiers to organise themselves quickly and conveniently.



NEW ADDITIONS 25/26

THE RESORT PLANS TO OPEN ON 29 NOVEMBER AND CLOSE ON 6 APRIL, WEATHER CONDITIONS PERMITTING. THE NEW SEASON IS OPENING WITH SIGNIFICANT TECH UPGRADES, EXPANDED SLOPES, CATERING IMPROVEMENTS, INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENTS, AND A FIRM COMMITMENT TO SUSTAINABILITY. THIS OVERALL COMMITMENT WILL ELEVATE THE VISITOR EXPERIENCE, CONSOLIDATING BAQUEIRA'S POSITION AS A LEADING DESTINATION IN THE PYRENEES.

1. SLOPES

The skiable area now encompasses **130 slopes with a total of 173 skiable kilometres**; 169 of which are marked runs and 4 off-piste. Five new blue slopes are being added this season – Cargolh, Lebre 1, Arrianglo, Poric and Sautarèth – expanding intermediate skiers' options significantly.

We've also made changes to the names of some routes to make it easier to identify them: the Glacèr is now part of the final section of Era Cascada, the former Lebre is now Lebre 2 and has changed from blue to red, and Argulls 1 has been renamed Obaga, Ta Beret 3 has taken the name Triton, Ta Beret 4 will be Gargolha and Egua 3 will now be known as Shiva.

In parallel, improvements have been made specifically for beginners: widening the Cascada run (Tortuga 2), opening of a new blue run in Lebre, the Cargolh turn-off connecting

Cabana to Orri, and the creation of a more accessible route in Cloth at the connection with Arrianglo.

2. DINING AND LEISURE

We're taking our gastronomic experiences further this season. **La Perdiu Blanca** restaurant at the **Hotel Montarto** has been fully renovated, improving the half-board experience at this 4-star hotel at the foot of the slopes. The former Drinkery has been transformed into a new après ski meeting point with sweet treats, becoming the **Xocolateria Jolonch**, a recognised brand owned by the traditional confectioner **Torrans Vicens**. The iconic **Moët Winter Lounge** is unveiling a new look, with a decor scheme that reinforces its exclusive character.



3. INFRASTRUCTURES

In terms of infrastructure, the resort is continuing to strengthen its technical capacity. This winter, we have two new snow groomers equipped with winches, allowing for more precise work on the slopes and access to tricky areas. In terms of snow production, **14 snowmakers have been installed** in the Ta Dossau area from Clot to Dossau, and the lower north face has been reinforced with low-pressure snow machines. Likewise, **12 old snowmakers** have been replaced by 6 next-generation models, offering greater energy efficiency and a reduced environmental impact. And there's more. Added to these investments, we've improved our slope preparations, using specialist machinery to reduce snow depths to ideal levels, and other actions with an emphasis on optimising safety and overall conditions..

4. SKI TRACK APP

Our major tech breakthrough this winter is our new **Ski Track App**, an app designed to take skiers through their day at the resort. Users can record their descents with detailed data like kilometres travelled, runs completed, and accumulated elevation gains. They can view routes in 3D and share locations in real time with other skiers. There's also an interactive 2D map with geolocation, enabling you to accurately track routes across the whole of Baqueira Beret.

5 SUSTAINABILITY

Our commitment to sustainability is ongoing, guiding Baqueira Beret's roadmap going forward. This season, innovations such as drone-enabled waste removal from waterways are being introduced, giving us the power to tackle the task with greater precision and speed. We've also worked on planting and reseeded certain sensitive areas to protect our precious ecosystem. Our plan to progressively replace snow fences is forging ahead, with an additional 2 kilometres now installed in Montgarri, Ruda, and Lenhador. These systems promote the natural accumulation of snow and help reduce the need for artificial production, reinforcing the resort's commitment to a more efficient and environmentally friendly management model.

In July, the upper area of the Noguera Pallaresa river was awarded a "Wild Rivers" distinction.

The project encompasses three snow parks and an indoor park, spread throughout the main areas of Baqueira Beret. Each one is specially designed according to the children's age range, with activities and settings tailored to their development.

BabyBAQUEIRA 1500 is aimed at children between 6 months and 3 years old, located in the cosy Borda chalet next to the Hotel Montarto. It offers sensory activities, workshops, free and symbolic play, film screenings and

At Baqueira 1500, you'll find the **Borda Lobató**, the oldest Aranese cabin in the area, which was there long before the first ski lifts arrived. Very close by, in the Fórum square of the Hotel Montarto, the **Wine Bar by Viña Pomal** serves up small plates in a modern setting with rustic vibes, all paired with wines from the prestigious Rioja winery Bodegas Bilbaínas. Also at the **Hotel Montarto**, and exclusively for guests, the newly refurbished **Buffet La Perdiu Blanca** has introduced a new dining concept to elevate their half-board experience, in a more modern and functional space.

And the Hotel Montarto has another new feature: the former Drinkery has been transformed into **Xocolateria Jolanch**, from the renowned brand owned by the traditional confectioner Torrons Vicens. Iberico produce from Jabugo, in a prime setting with the best views of the Val d'Aran and great peaks of the Pyrenees. Next to it, the **La Choza Cafeteria**, opened last season, boasts a young and functional ambience with a relaxed menu including burgers, ramen and light bites, as well as a panoramic terrace where you can enjoy a quick snack using the click and collect system. With its iconic circular construction, the **Restaurant-Bar 2200** remains a Baqueira classic, serving a selection of small plates, fondue and steaks, all with a side of spectacular panoramic views.

The **Discovery SDF** robot is another highlight, specialising in structuring the ski base and optimising both glide on changing snow conditions and edge grip. Meanwhile, the Wax Future waxer uses infrared to achieve competition-level waxing with improved wax penetration and superior durability.

High-end rentals are another key feature of Baqueira Store. Equipment is constantly updated, and customers can even swap models every day to try out different options. If you ultimately decide to purchase the skis you try, the rental fee will be deducted from the purchase price.

You can process everything either in person or online, with a system designed to save time: enter your data in advance via the website, so your equipment is ready when you arrive in-store. A foot scanning service is also available at the Montarto Hotel, meaning every customer can find the perfect boot for their foot shape and width.

SUSTAINABILITY

BAQUEIRA BERET: SUSTAINABILITY AND COMMITMENT TO THE ENVIRONMENT

This season, Baqueira Beret is reinforcing its commitment to sustainability, adding new innovations that protect and preserve our natural environment. One of the standout measures being implemented is a drone-enabled system to remove waste from waterways and hard-to-reach areas, allowing these tasks to be performed more quickly and accurately. We're also planting and reseeded sensitive areas to preserve and regenerate vegetation. The resort is also continuing works on progressively expanding its snow fences, adding two kilometres in Montgarri, Ruda, and Lenhador to promote natural snow accumulation and reduce the need for artificial snow production.

Meanwhile, in July the upper part of the Noguera Pallaresa river was awarded the "Wild Rivers" distinction, an international recognition of its excellent state of conservation and compatibility between human activity and environmental protection. The 30-km stretch encompasses 10 km in the Val d'Aran and 20 km in Pallars. There are no inhabited villages in this section; water flows down the river from high mountain streams, completely untouched by human intervention

The Alt Pirineu Natural Park and Aran General Council began the application process five years ago in a bid to make the upper course of the Noguera Pallaresa river eligible for international Wild Rivers Site certification. It's the first river in Europe to achieve the distinction outside of France, where the award was created in 2007 when the European Framework Directive was deemed insufficient.

In October 2023, the resort received the **Biosphere Committed** seal, certifying its strong environmental practices and adherence to the 2030 Agenda's 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), also strengthening





collaboration with public and private institutions on environmental projects.

Baqueira Beret is already working on a wide range of actions to ensure the harmonious coexistence between tourism and the natural environment. These include **hydroseeding** and fertilisation over summer, working with local farmers on the **regeneration** of pastures, and introducing **selective waste collection**, both in facilities and in the natural environment, gradually eliminating single-use plastics and promoting **recycling** throughout the resort. Similarly, the old disposable ski passes have been replaced with top-up BaqueiraPASS and BaqueiraTICKET passes, contributing to the reduction of waste as well as the emissions involved in manufacturing.

Energy efficiency and a **reduced impact on the landscape** are other key components of the sustainability plan, and have already been implemented. The resort uses monitoring systems to reduce fuel consumption and optimise the use of snow groomers and improve the efficiency of snow guns. It invests in smart systems, building insulation and low-con-

sumption LED lighting, and purchases electricity from renewable sources. Sustainable mobility has also been reinforced, with the installation of electric vehicle charging stations and the promotion of eco-friendly transport solutions.

We protect **biodiversity**, implementing various strategies we started last season, including research into, and the **conservation of local species** such as the grey partridge, planting native vegetation, and signposting sensitive areas to minimise human impact. We also clean up and monitor waste in hard-to-reach areas using drones, ensuring that the mountains are kept in the best possible condition.

Baqueira Beret also promotes **corporate social responsibility**, collaborating with the local community on cultural, educational and sports initiatives, supporting adapted sports, promoting the Aranese language, and participating in social and healthcare programmes. As a resort, this represents our consistent integration of environmental sustainability and social commitment, offering visitors a nature-friendly, safe and enriching experience in every sense.

THE VAL D'ARAN *and* VALLS D'ÀNEU RESORT

The resort is made up of four large areas, each with its own personality: **Baqueira, Beret, Bonaigua and Baciver**. The majority of slopes are on the Atlantic-facing side of the Pyrenees, guaranteeing decent amounts of high quality snow throughout the season. It's easy to access via both valleys – through the Vielha tunnel or the Bonaigua mountain pass – while the course of the Garona river marks the natural connection with France.

Spanning a total area of 2,273 hectares, the resort offers **173 skiable kilometres** distributed across **130 runs (127 km of slopes and 3 km off-piste)**, guaranteeing varied, fluid and uncrowded skiing. The resort, covering an elevation change of 1,110 metres, starts at Baqueira 1,500 and reaches 2,610 metres at Cap de Baciver, a haven for freeride fans.

The natural snow conditions make Baqueira Beret a prime destination for winter sports lovers, as endorsed by skiers and snowboarders alike. As well as the slopes, the resort offers 7 kilometres of cross-country ski trails, a Snowpark, boardercross, funpark and Audi Ski Kronos, along with a host of other facilities for maximum fun in the snow, guaranteed. And the experience goes beyond the snow. The Val d'Aran and the Valls d'Àneu are known for their Romanesque architectural heritage and traditional cuisine that epitomises the culinary essence of the Pyrenees.

The resort of Baqueira Beret is characterised by its ability to combine tradition and modernity, nature and services, sports and cuisine. Spanning more than 2,200 hectares with 173 skiable kilometres, the resort offers slopes and landscapes that give everyone – from adrenaline junkies to families – maximum snow enjoyment. The Atlantic orientation, altitude and quality of facilities make for the ideal overall experience, with guaranteed snow production and easy access from the Val d'Aran, Valls d'Àneu and France.

The essence of the resort is reflected in its authenticity, inextricably linked to its Aranese and Pallarès character. In its commitment to sustainability, outstanding cuisine and accessibility, thanks to numerous entry points and diverse terrain. This is a place where every day is a unique experience, where skiing is combined with culture, leisure and nature.

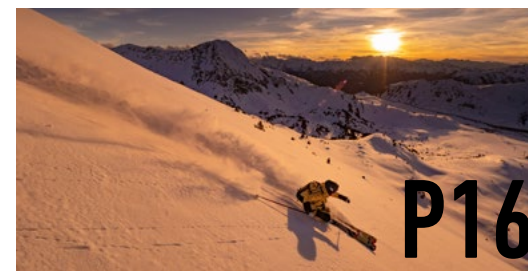
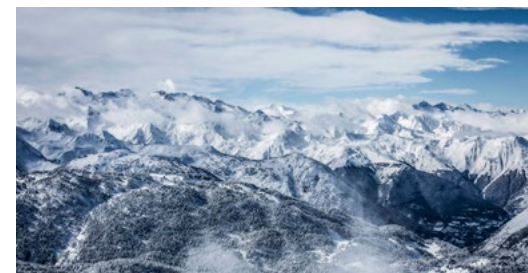
THE ESSENCE OF THE RESORT IS REFLECTED IN ITS AUTHENTICITY, INEXTRICABLY LINKED TO ITS ARANESE AND PALLARÉS CHARACTER. IN ITS COMMITMENT TO SUSTAINABILITY AND HIGH-END, HIGH-ALTITUDE CUISINE.

The resort is divided into four large areas, each with its own personality. **Baqueira** is the beating heart of the resort and a natural meeting point, with its hotel complex, cable car and main connections. The 37.5 km of slopes combine challenging descents like Luis Arias or Cara Nord with accessible areas ideal for beginners, located at an altitude of 1800 metres.

Beret represents spaciousness and tranquillity. A vast 74 km of sunny, open and gentle slopes make it a favourite of families and beginners, as well as the competition clubs training at Fernández Ochoa Stadium or riders who enjoy the Era Marmota snowpark.

Bonaigua, on the other hand, is where the excitement ramps up: the gateway to the Pallars, it brings together the majority of the resort's black runs on a varied terrain totalling 38.4 km. It's home to both accessible areas and only-for-the-brave descents like Peüllà.

Last but not least, **Baciver** is the epitome of adrenaline and altitude. With its summit at 2,610 m, it offers 17.2 km of technical red and black runs, with a high-altitude ambience that's made it the local mecca for freeriders. Together, the four areas of Baqueira Beret form a diverse and balanced domain, with something for all levels and offering more than just skiing: a prime destination in the heart of the Pyrenees.

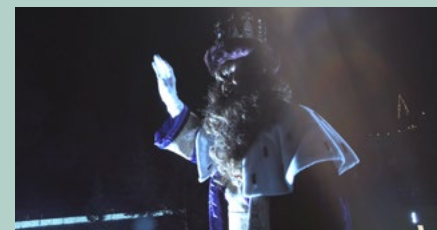

THE VAL D'ARAN

In the Pyrenees of Lleida province lies Val d'Aran, the only valley with an Atlantic character in Spain and a privileged location due to the quality of its snow. Specifically in Pla de Beret are the sources of the rivers Garonne and Noguera Pallaresa. This is a valley surrounded by peaks that reach 3,000 metres in height and which contains more than two hundred lakes. Some, such as the Mar or the Tort de Rius, are the largest in the Spanish Pyrenees. Its large forests consist of firs, pines and beech.

Val d'Aran preserves and maintains its hugely rich artistic and cultural heritage. It includes numerous churches: Salardú, Arties, Vielha, Bossòst; the beloved carvings of Romanesque images such as the Christ of Salardú, Casarilh and Vielha; the unique baptismal fonts and holy water of Arties, Vilac and Vilamòs; and works of art dating from the 12th and 13th centuries that form a unique and exceptional artistic heritage.

As a complete architectural unit, the towns of Val d'Aran are formed by buildings of stone, slate and wood, in which the Romanesque and Gothic style churches particularly stand out.

A characteristic element of the Val d'Aran is its language: Aranese. It is a living language spoken by the people of the country. It belongs to the Occitan branch of languages and is a variant of the Gascon language of Comminges, while retaining its own personality. Another important

heritage of Val d'Aran is the richness of its gastronomy. Aranese cuisine is heavily influenced, given the location of the valley's.

THE VALLS D'ÀNEU

The Valls d'Àneu are valleys bordering with the Val d'Aran. Located in the municipality of Alt Aneu, across the natural barriers of the Bon-aigua Pass and the foothills of the National Park of Sant Maurici and Aigüestortes, they are almost an extension of the Aranese lands. The clearly Pyrenean character gives these valleys their beautiful scenery.

The Valls d'Àneu offer a variety of treasures. Along with their physical charm and their unique landscape, there are other features worth mentioning. The cuisine, sports, art and culture have helped shape these valleys' unique character. The proximity to the Val d'Aran makes it easy for visitors to travel between one area and the other. Along with the typical constructions of Pyrenean architecture, with stone walls and slate roofs, these valleys are dotted with Romanesque churches in their purest form, with magnificent examples of religious art and architecture. For example, the parish church of Sant Llisier in Alos d'Isil, the church of Saint John in Isil or the church of Sant Just and Sant Pastor in the small hamlet of Son. These are some of the most characteristic buildings, and their artistic treasures, many of which are now exhibited in the Museu d'Art of Catalunya.



A LOOK BACK *at* THE PAST

Since the inauguration on December 6th, 1964 of the first chairlift, Baqueira Beret has experienced important growth.

In December 1982, after 7 years of negotiations, the Reina chairlift opened, the first ski lift in the Beret area.

In December 1985 the Dossau chairlift completed the first phase of the development of Beret. In 1988 the skiable area of Baqueira was expanded with the opening of the new Argulls area, featuring three triple chairlifts giving access to 150 ha of skiable area. Argulls is the area that accumulates the most snow in the Resort, and the terrain is made up entirely of grass.

In 1990 the most important investment was made in a single season, with the implementation of the snow production system covering the main axes of Baqueira Beret, and the opening of the second quadruple express chairlift "Mirador", which gives access to the Cap de Baqueira from 1800 in just 7 minutes.

The major new feature of the 92/93 season was the preparation of the new North Face/ Cascada run, which travels from the Cap de Baqueira to Baqueira 1500, adding 5.5 kilometres in length with 1,000 metres vertical drop.

In 1994 BAQUEIRA/BERET inaugurated a new access to its slopes, with a service centre and the "Bonaigua" chairlift, by the Port de la Bonaigua, connecting it with another valley: the Vall d'Aneu and area, Pallars.

In 1995 the snow production system was installed in Beret, and in 1997 the installation was broadened between the two areas of Baqueira and Beret and to ensure their connection.

In 1998 the resort's first six-seater express chairlift was launched, the new Pla de Baqueira, replacing the two-seater

of the same name. Its ability to transport 3000 people per hour, 1,800 metre length and the remodelling of the Mirador and Pla de Baqueira runs allowed for more skiing in Baqueira, while relieving congestion in other areas.

In 1999, the launch of the resort's second six-seater express chairlift "Dera Reina" in Beret improved the quality of skiing in that area and facilitated the connection with Baqueira.

In 2000 the four-seater express chairlift "Blanhiblar" and the "Costarjàs" ski lift in Beret were launched, opening up a huge off-piste skiable area. The new "Teso dera Mina" chairlift in Argulls gave access to several faces and "couloirs" for expert skiers. A total of 100 more hectares of skiable terrain was opened up.

In 2002 the historic Luis Arias ski lift was removed, and replaced by a spectacular black run. Two other important projects were also approved: works to expand Bonaigua with a new access from Alt Aneu, and the works for additional parking at Cota 1500 with 1500 places. The new Baqueira Beret office in Vielha was opened.

In 2003 the first phase of the Bonaigua expansion project was built, with three new chairlifts (two express four-seaters: La Peüllà and Bonaigua, and one two-seater: Cap del Port), three ski runs (La Peüllà, Pleta del Duc and Cresta de Bonaigua) and two ski touring routes (Gerber y Lo Boscàs). A new services centre was also opened at Bonaigua 1900.

In 2004 the Era Cabana express chairlift was opened in Baqueira 1800, serving three new blue ski runs: Era Cabana, Era Coma and Ta Orri. In Bonaigua, an intermediate station for beginners was built on the Cap de Port chairlift, giving access to a new run: Debutants. The skiable area of Peüllà was also expanded



with the construction of four new ski runs: Cap a Baqueira (blue), Les Paletes and Bosc de la Peüllà (red), La Perdiu (red) and Pala Gran (black).

The main event of 2005 was the installation of the resort's first gondola lift. The Baqueira gondola lift, with 78 nine-seater cabins, climbs from 1500 to 1800 together with the Bosque chairlift. The beginners' area of Baqueira 1900 was completely remodelled. The Pastores ski lifts were dismantled and the Rabada ski lift and magic carpets were relocated for better convenience for the skiers.

In 2006 the beginners' area of Baqueira 1800 was remodelled with 3 covered magic carpets, the first of their kind in Spain. Skiing for kids and beginners was improved, and access to the gondola lift from the Bosque cafeteria was made easier for pedestrians. The Bonaigua 2072 service area was expanded.

The green run Era Coma was created in the Cabana area. In 2008 the work to improve access to Pallars was completed, with a new variant from Guingueta d'Aneu to Mare de Déu de les Ares, and another which connected Sorpe with Boren. The new underground car park in Ruda became fully operational, with 1400 places and direct access to the Baqueira gondola lift. A new facility with ski lockers was opened below the lower station of the gondola lift. The new stretch of the gondola lift connecting the urban area of Ruda and the new car park with the slopes was launched. Two new five star hotels and one four-star opened their doors in Ruda.

In 2009 the resort's oldest chairlift was dismantled, the Horat deth Bò, in Orri and the Choza chairlift was remodelled. This step was the first phase of the project to install the Jorge Jordana chairlift planned for the 2010/2011 season. The slope grooming department received a major investment with the purchase of five new state-of-the-art machines.

The new star of 2010 was the inauguration of the Jorge Jordana express chairlift, connecting the Orri area with the Cap de Baqueira, the highest point of the resort, giving access to the whole mountain. Four new runs were marked out: Egua 2, Egua 3, Tuc deth Miei and Pala del Teso. The launch of the new Moët Winter Lounge at Orri was undoubtedly highly valued by our customers, offering a whole new experience.

In 2012 the Bosque cafeteria was renovated and the lower part of the Manaud run was redeveloped, as was the Tuc de la Llança ski lift and the final stretch of the Ticolet run. 3 Safari itineraries were proposed on the website, with a new app for smartphones and images of all the slopes on Google Streetview.

In 2014 the station celebrated its 50th anniversary in full style, offering visitors 21 more routes, thereby expanding from 120 km to 146 km of pistes, and 7 km of off-piste routes, making a total of 153 km for the 2014-2015 winter across a wide skiable area of 2,166 hectares. New ski lifts were premiered, such as the TDS Jesus Serra, replacing Vista Beret for increased capacity. No less important were the Saumet ski lift that opened a new ski area in Bacier, and the Fernández Ochoa ski lift which served to improve the service for the clubs training at Beret Stadium.

In 2015 the three new ski runs in Beret raised the total to 155 km. Creation of the Ski Kronos, timed track in Baqueira. 18 new snow makers were installed, to increase and improve the efficiency of the system. Three new machines were acquired for slope preparation. A new dining and après ski area in the Montarto, with the opening of the Wine Bar restaurant and Drinkery Bar. Renovation of the hotel reception area and Ski Servicespace with a high-end store. In the Bosque Restaurant and Café located at Baqueira 1800 underwent a total renovation, considerably expanding its space to make it the largest in the

resort, and introducing the “free flow” concept to allow better and more convenient mobility for visitors. On the slopes, the new Blanqueta run was launched to connect the lower part of Tubo Nere and the ridges towards the north face which have good snowfall, expanding the skiable area of the north face in search of those places where the snow is abundant and of high quality. The inclusion of La Pasarell, the historic off-piste of the North Face, in the ski runs, created what is surely the most difficult run of the whole resort.

In 2019, Baqueira's highest peak reached 2,610 m, adding 100 m of slope following the installation of the Baciver ski lift up to the peak of the same name. Beginning this season, Baqueira Beret boasts runs of more than 1,100 metres down to the base at Baqueira 1500. The Funpark is installed in the Clot der Os (Beret), as part of the policy of offering new experiences to skiers. Lastly, it will host the FIS Snowboard Cross World Cup for the second time in March to great sporting, attendance and media success.

2020 is a season which stands out for the COVID-19 outbreak, which required the Resort to close a month earlier than planned due to the national lockdown in Spain to combat the pandemic. During winter we set about with the digital transformation of Baqueira Beret to offer a wider range of services, with the star being the BaqueiraPASS, improving the user experience.

In 2021, a different season due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the Resort was affected by travel restrictions between regions. But with the commitment to remain partially open from the first to the last day of the season.

The Dossau TDS opened in 2023, making this area in the far northwest of the resort ever-more popular.

In 2024, the Barqueta, Vista Beret and Bosque slopes reached 170 km of runs. In Baqueira 1800, La Choza coffee shop was opened, in homage to the old chairlift of the same name, with a new “click & collect” online order system. The resort's 60th anniversary was also celebrated with a revival of the successful FIS European Cup events that hadn't been held since 1974.





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
